The Ecumenical Food Pantry exists as a source of help for individuals and families during difficult times, such as a sudden job loss, temporary disability, domestic violence, illness, or some other challenge.

**Registration Requirements:** These requirements must be met on the second visit to the pantry.

- Proof of Pike County Residence. Examples of proof of residence include a driver's license or documentation with the client's name and address, such as a telephone or utility bill, bank statement, lease document, rent payment receipts, copy of money order for rent payment, letter from official government agency, or a letter from employer.
- Completed Self-Declaration of Need Form. This form can be completed at the time of registration.

**Food Distribution:** The pantry distributes food every Friday. No appointment is necessary. Pantry hours are as follows:

- Noon – 1:30 pm
- 6:30 pm – 7:30 pm
